## APPRENTICESHIP



### SCHEME OF THE WEEK

The Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship route means officers gain their degree level professional qualification whilst working and training. Apprentices start on an initial salary of over £28,000. West Mercia's scheme is currently open for applications.



Army Musicians deliver musical support to the Army and the wider defence community. They are a vital part of state occasions such as the King's Coronation. All of the armed forces have their own full time musicians including the **RAF** and the **Royal Navy**.



Telford College offers a Public Services Level 3 BTEC qualification for 16+ applicants. Students who complete the course commonly go on to join the police or fire service or can continue to university or join an Apprenticeship scheme.

### Become a Paramedic

Paramedics are highly trained individuals who make life-saving decisions under pressure whilst putting patients and their families at ease. They have to combine excellent social skills with vast medical knowledge. If you think you have what it takes to become a Paramedic you can do so by studying a Paramedic Science Degree or via a Degree Apprenticeship.



The Royal Fleet Auxiliary is a Merchant Navy organisation of civilian-crewed ships providing logistic and operational support to the Royal Navy and Royal Marines. Members are uniformed civilians who provide medical and logistical support and are involved with operations to provide humanitarian aid, counter piracy and narcotic patrols as well assisting with conflict prevention and safeguarding international trade.



### RAF Drone Pilot

RAF Drone Pilots provide close-air support, gather intelligence and conduct strategic air strikes. Drone pilots control the aircraft and go through the same preparation such as pre-flight planning, comprehensive briefing, hand-over, weather, intelligence and usual air-space flight considerations as any other RAF pilot. Drone Pilots are commissioned officers in the RAF with a starting salary of over £31,000.
