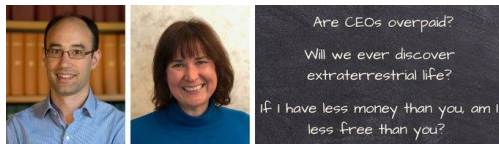

Art therapy is a form of psychotherapy that uses art as its main form of expression.

Art therapists work with other healthcare professionals and look at the best form of art media to use with clients. They can work one-to-one or with groups. The idea is not to teach art but to allow the various art media to be a means of communication.

Therapists work with young people and adults with mental health problems, learning difficulties and in a variety of settings including head injury units, education, drug and alcohol rehabilitation and the prison service.
