

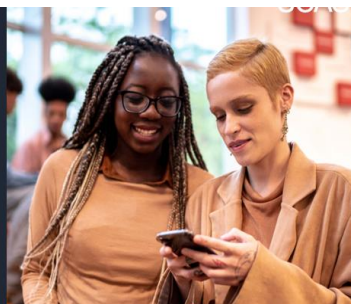
This is a really good starting point if you are wondering how to support a pupil and discover what has changed since you were at school.


