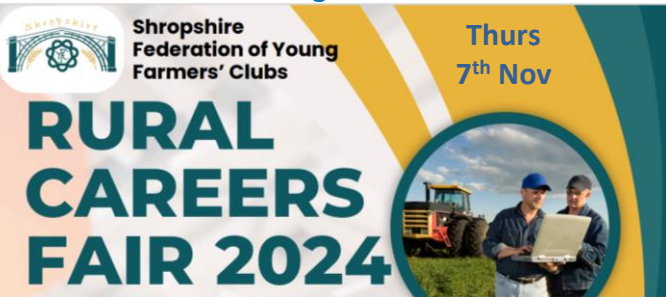
Food Scientist

Climate change and conflicts all threaten our food security and food scientists will be at the forefront of finding solutions to help ensure everyone has access to high quality nutritious food.

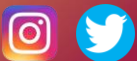
