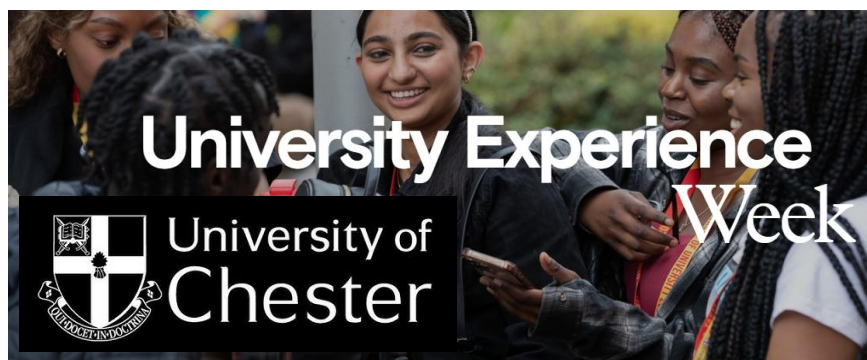
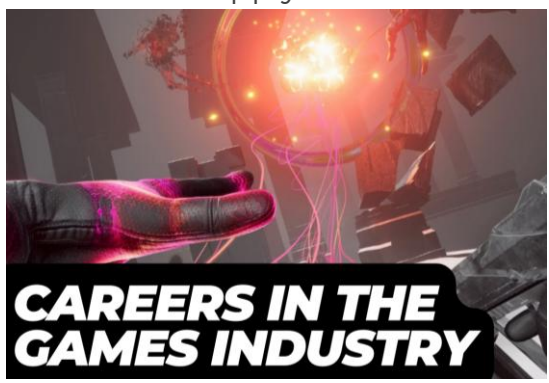

The nDreams virtual work experience programme offers a behind-the-scenes look at life in a games studio. You'll explore roles like character art, level design and the coding that brings games to life.
