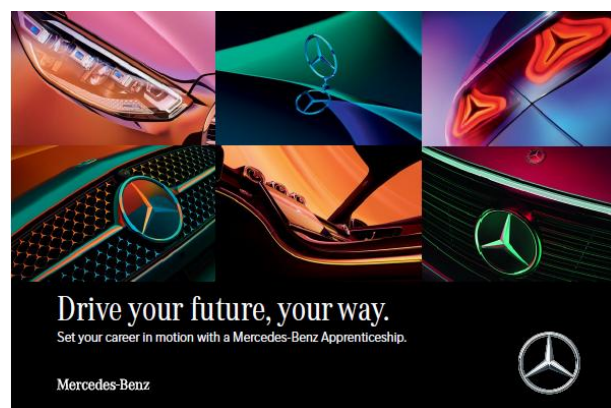


The Power to Change Lives: Biomedical Sciences at Lancaster

These unique courses from the EDT (Engineering Development Trust) are for Lower 6th pupils interested in STEM subjects and take place at various top universities. Participants will experience university-style lectures and work on activities and group projects with the support of academics and student mentors. Pupils stay in halls of residence and will take part in social activities in the evenings. Funding is available for pupils for whom the cost, from £475, would be a barrier.
