At Haberdashers' Adams pupils study three A-levels in the Sixth Form. In addition, they study **either** one AS-level **or** the Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) in the Lower Sixth. A very small number complete four A-levels in the Upper Sixth.

All A-level courses are two-year courses whereas the AS-level courses and the EPQ take one year and are completed in the Lower Sixth. It is **not** normally possible to "drop" an A-level part way through the Sixth Form. Pupils also take part in a non-examination lecture programme, to enrich their experience - which includes guest speakers from outside the school - and an afternoon of sport each week.

Pupils must study **three A-levels** and either **one AS-level**, or the **Extended Project Qualification**, choosing one subject from each of block A, B C and D.
