## Bangor University College of Medicine and Health Webinars

Pupils are invited to join a series of free online Taster Sessions - live, interactive lectures created specifically for those exploring their options before applying to university. Sessions are available across a wide range of subjects including Sport Science, Medicine, Pharmacy, Pharmacology, Nursing, Midwifery, Biomedical Science, Medical Science, Psychology and Health & Social Care.

Insight into University is a virtual programme designed to help students explore STEM degrees, apprenticeships and related career pathways. Participants gain access to a range of experiences, including insights into university life, STEM projects developed by leading UK universities and global companies, first-year university lectures and live sessions with academics, admissions tutors, apprentices, employers and current students. The programme runs over 8 weeks and £99, but bursaries are available for eligible pupils.



## INSIGHT INTO UNIVERSITY



The Future Pathways Scholars Programme is a fully funded, two-day virtual bootcamp designed to help Year 10–12 pupils explore academic pathways, understand emerging career opportunities and prepare strategically for university admissions. The programme includes structured academic enrichment, mentorship and masterclasses, making it ideal for students beginning to make subject and university choices.
